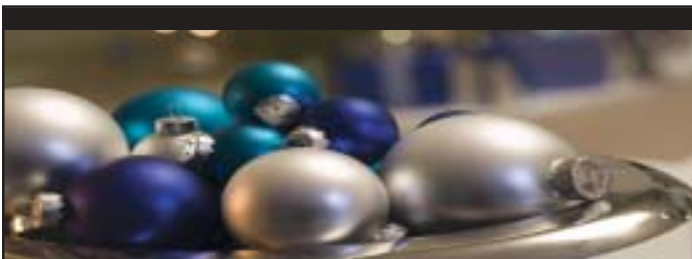

Ponderosa FD November Round Up

Thanksgiving and deep fried turkeys – Almost every year we respond to some type of fire involving deep frying turkeys. You must be very careful, read the instructions, cook OUTSIDE and away from any overhangs, structures or other combustibles.

Wear gloves, eye protection and a long sleeved jacket. Be very aware that when you lower the turkey into the hot oil the remaining moisture will BOIL and cause the oil to splash, sometimes enough to spill over and cause an oil fire from the direct propane flame. The key to safely cooking a turkey is to measure the oil by using water FIRST. Dip the turkey (before seasoning) into the pot and mark the water level, then replace the water with the oil. Leave at least 6 inches of open space above the submerged bird since some water will be within the bird.

Assure that your propane supply is as far away as possible; consider a “shield”. If the worst happens, call 9-1-1, and don’t use water on the burning oil. If you follow this procedure, you should be eating that wonderful turkey without exposure to a disaster.

Construction of the new fire station on Louetta is underway!! It’s been a long journey navigating the bid and legal processes.

We have experienced a 10% loss of revenue for 2010 due to the economic realities. The 2011 budget will see some services reduced and all budget categories will be affected.

Please be safe during this holiday season. Common sense is an appropriate way to reduce injuries and preventing fires.

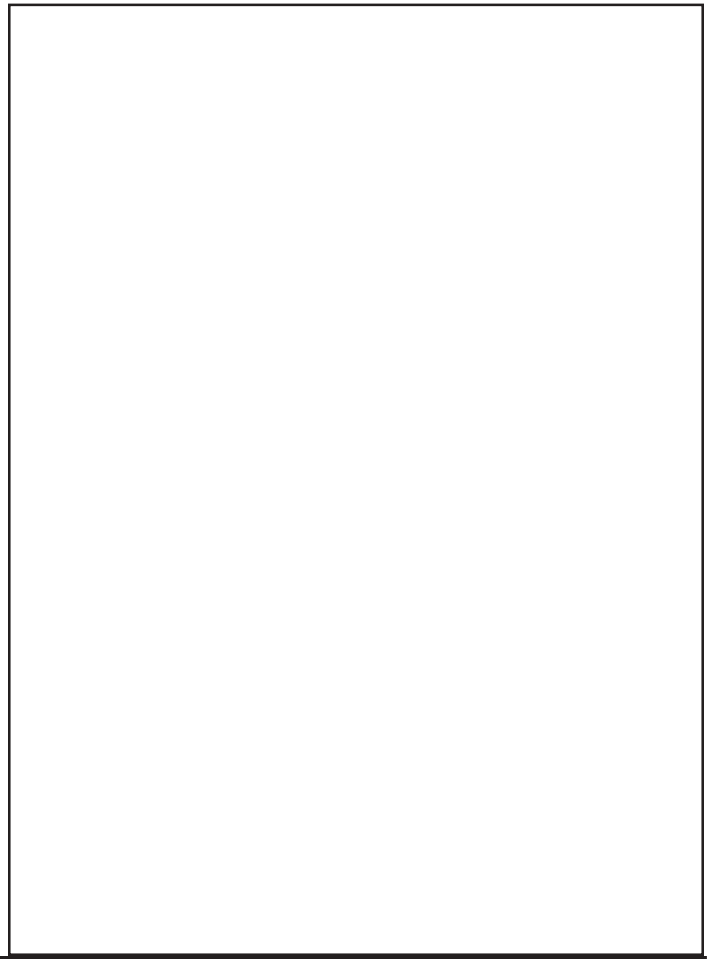

KISD Honors Edwin G. (Butch) Theiss

On October 9, the field at Klein Memorial Stadium became the Butch Theiss Field, honoring a member of the first Klein High football team who has remained one of the team's strongest supporters. He has attended approximately 500 Klein Bearkat football games.

Theiss played basketball in high school, but not football because Klein had no team. After graduating in 1947, he went back for a semester to play on the first Klein football team for Coach Joe Rogillio. The school allowed Theiss to play on the team while taking an extra semester of course work because the Bearkats were not participating in district competition.

The team started workouts with 35 players, but only 22 finished the season. According to Theiss, some of the players had never seen a football game. Therefore, the coach started with the basics.

Theiss, a co-captain, played left end although his first choice of positions was quarterback. He played in every game, scoring six touchdowns in eight games. His first touchdown was during the game against Spring Branch. The team's record was three wins and four losses.

After his extra semester at Klein High, Theiss began his career with Southwestern Bell in 1948 and became an on-call volunteer for the team. For 20 years, he climbed poles at the field to maintain the lights, barely finishing his first assignment before the kick-off. He also supplied and maintained field telephones for the coaches and press box.

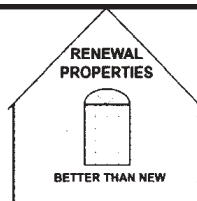
Beginning in 1977, the original football team began ten-year reunions, changing to five-year reunions in 1997. At the team's sixtieth reunion, each received a KHS letter jacket.

Theiss, like his father, served on the Klein ISD Board of Trustees. His years of service were 1967-1985. He worked for the KISD from 1985-2002 after retiring from Southwestern Bell.
