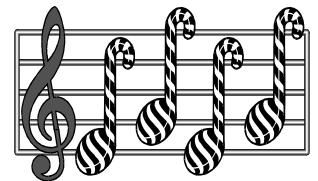

# FM 1960 Goes Green

The Houston Northwest Chamber of Commerce announced that the Texas Department of Transportation is moving forward on their plan to install raised medians along nine miles of FM 1960 from I-45 to Mills Road. This project grew out of the FM 1960 Access Management Study conducted in 2004, which reported that the crash rate of FM 1960 was 217% higher than other parts of the state. TXDOT's objective with this project is to reduce accidents and to improve the flow of traffic.

"Now the real work begins," says Barbara Thomason, President of the Houston Northwest Chamber of Commerce. "Now that the project is funded and the bid awarded, we as a community must join together to raise about \$600,000 to see that these medians are beautifully landscaped."

The Green Medians Committee of the Houston Northwest Chamber of Commerce is the engine behind this effort, under the leadership of Barbara Schlattman of Barbara Schlattman Interiors. Barbara and her husband, dentist Dr. Rusty Schlattman have lived in the Champions area for 36 years and are committed to preserving and developing the area's natural beauty. Barbara began this effort with a few friends and neighbors because they did not want to see medians installed with cement that eventually turns into weeds.

"As an interior designer, I care about the aesthetics in our surroundings" says Schlattman, "This is one way that we will see a significant improvement in what we consider to be our main street. Greening FM 1960 will improve property values while causing people to slow down and enjoy their surroundings."

Planted medians will help revitalize the area, entice new businesses and homeowners to relocate to our area and add scenic beauty. It is also believed that the medians will cause a new wave of pride in our community and the financial burden will not have an impact on the citizens. The maintenance and water for the medians will be funded through a joint powers board created by 14 community-conscious water districts along the FM 1960 corridor. The letter of agreement creating this board has been finalized, signed, and received by the attorneys for the MUDs. The MUDs have indicated there will be no increase in their taxes in order to fund the maintenance of the medians.

The Green Medians Steering Committee is now focused on raising funds for planting TXDOT's medians. Although the

committee has no input in the location, quantity, size or shape of the medians, they will be involved in the landscape design. All landscape plans must be submitted to TXDOT for review and approval. The design will be driven by a prudent use of water and maintenance. The required watering system is a drip system which is safer for traffic and uses less water. The Green Medians Committee would also like to have rain sensors installed so the water will shut off during rainy days.

The landscape architect is designing three plans: Plan A which has the most landscaping; Plan B & Plan C will be modified versions with less landscaping. The goal is to raise \$600,000 for plan A. To date, \$50,000 has been raised with a fundraising deadline set for April 2010. TXDOT will be placing pavers in many of the areas that don't have landscaping and will excavate through the road to provide dirt for the landscaped medians.

TXDOT will begin construction in January 2010 after the holiday rush and will take about nine months to complete the work. The work on this project will be done at night to minimize the impact on businesses. Landscaping the medians will begin after TXDOT has completed construction of the medians.

"This is a great example of a public-private partnership," asserts Schlattman, "and unique in that we will do this as a grass roots efforts among caring citizens!"

Green Medians is the project committee of the Houston Northwest Chamber of Commerce for this effort and the fundraising falls under the Houston Northwest Chamber of Commerce Foundation which accepts tax deductible donations. Green Medians donations are designated only for this project and the Chamber will cover the administration of the fundraising effort.

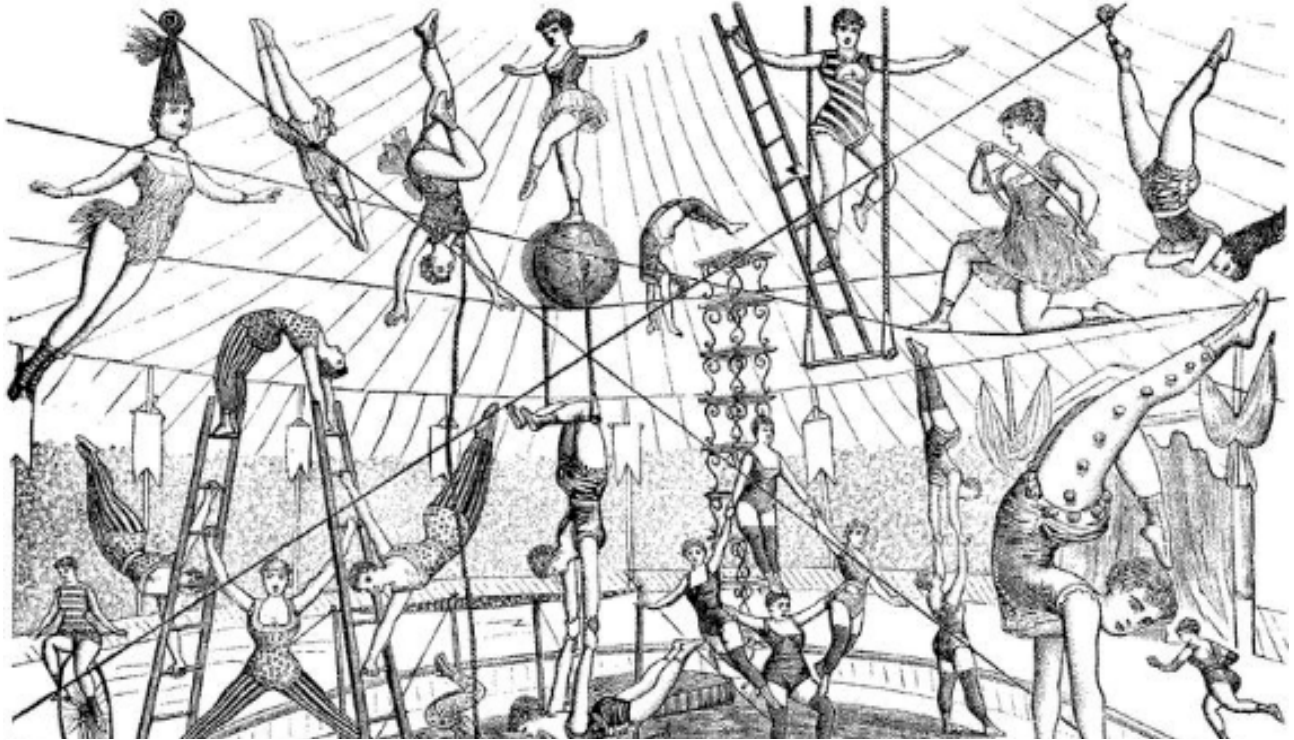
