If you see anything suspicious occurring in Cypresswood, please call immediately to report it. The non-emergency number is 713-221-6000 (give the deputy's unit number to the dispatch officer) and always call 911 if it is an emergency. Please state you are a Cypresswood resident. Giving a deputy's service number may slow down a response, so don't do it unless you specifically want the neighborhood deputy to respond.

The perpetrators of these crimes seem to be selectively choosing their targets. They choose house where the neighbors seem to be away.
