

## **Cypresswood Security Alerts**

If you see anything suspicious occurring in Cypresswood, please call immediately to report it. The non-emergency number is 713-221-6000 (give the deputies unit number to the dispatch officer) and always call 911 if it is an emergency. Please state you area a Cypresswood resident.

### **Posted January 20, 2009**

On January 20, 2009, a home invasion occurred near Fir Forest and Navajo Trail. Four individuals entered the house and one was apprehended. This was not a random invasion; the suspects were supposedly motivated by revenge and knew the owner of the house.

### **Posted January 20, 2009**

On January 16, 2009, a motor vehicle was burglarized on El James near Mantana. A portable DVD player was stolen. Residents are reminded to keep their vehicle locked at all times even in their driveways.

### **Posted January 20, 2009**

On December 29, 2008, two individuals were apprehended discharging firearms in Cypresswood. It is not believed they were shooting at anything or anyone. Since this was a parole violation, previous sentences were immediately reinstated for the two individuals.

### **Posted August 12, 2008**

One recent afternoon around 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. a purse was left in view in a locked automobile at the west clubhouse parking lot. A passenger window was found broken and the purse was stolen. Keep all valuables out of sight, preferably locked in the trunk.

Also a resident reports that a male knocked on the homeowner's door to ask if a parked car was for sale. When this person was told the car was not for sale, he left quickly and in the process tore up some of the curbing.

### **Posted June 30, 2008**

Please keep your car doors locked even while in your driveway during the day. Our Deputy reports that there have been recent thefts from cars during daylight hours in the Huntwick and Olde Oaks subdivisions. These cars were unlocked and often parked in driveways. Motion sensors attached to lights are deterrents to this kind of activity during nighttime hours. Be sure yours are working properly.

No Soliciting signs are posted at all entrances to Cypresswood. Call the deputies if you see a solicitors or someone you don't recognize walking the neighborhood. Religious groups are considered as solicitors.

Keep your doors locked while filling gas. A resident reported a friend had her purse stolen from the opposite side of the car while filling gas. This was reported at a station along Kuykendahl.

### **Posted June 4, 2008**

On June 4, two unidentified males entered an unlocked door in the back of a house on Alderwood and committed criminal mischief in the premises.

This house is unoccupied and for sale through a local realtor. The door had been unlocked for an undetermined amount of time.

Please make sure all doors are locked at all times and continue to report suspicious activity.
